

Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections



Aadhar Coverage across Prevailing Caste Sections





Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section












Households with and without toilets across different prevailing caste section in village



Use of toilets across different prevailing caste section in village








Source Wise Irrigation Coverage among then households





Percentage cropped area of major crops




Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops






Cattle population, productivity, shelter and waste




Lighting Source and usage in Village


