


#### Gender Wise Population Across Age Groups



Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section












Drainage Linked to Households






#### Households with and without toilets across different prevailing caste section in village



#### Use of toilets across different prevailing caste section in village



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


#### Source Wise Irrigation Coverage among then households






Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops






Cattle population, productivity, shelter and waste
