## Department Advisory Board (DAB) Meeting

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Date: 20 Jan 2014

#### Minutes of Department Advisory Board Meeting held on 30-11-2013 in Main Seminar Hall of MJCET

The 1<sup>st</sup> DAB Meeting of Information Technology Department was held on 30-11-2013 in Main Seminar Hall of MJCET. The meeting was attended in full strength by all designated members of the board comprising of Head ITD, Associated Head ITD, and Program Coordinator for ITD, Representatives from Professional Bodies, Employers, Parents, and Alumni, Current Final Year Students, and designated Senior faculty members of ITD, and members of NBA Core Committee-MJCET. The meeting was presided by Head ITD.

- Mrs. Maniza Hijab, Head ITD, started the proceedings of the meeting by introducing each member of the DAB and the members of NBA Core Committee-MJCET members.
- Dr. Ashfaque Jaferi, Dean Academics and NBA Coordinator made a brief presentation on the need for NBA and the framework for implementation of Outcome Based Education System in accordance with NBA criteria to be implemented by the college.
- Brief presentation about the IT department covering aspects related to Infrastructure (both computing and non-computing), Faculty profile, IT-Course Curriculum, Student Evaluation and Results, Student Placements, Professional body Student Chapters etc was made by the Head.
- Post the brief department presentation, the SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats) compiled by the department was presented before the committee for review and discussion.
- Then the Head invited Dr. Atul Negi to start the open discussion.
- Dr. Atul Negi asked each of the DAB members to put forth their views and suggestions.
- Dr. M.M. Hussain, Parent Representative on the board expressed his overall satisfaction of the department and the college and emphasized on
  - Consideration of R & D related projects with utility base for student projects.
  - Handling of First Year Class work and the Students by Experienced Faculty.
- Then the Alumni Members spoke on their 4 year college experience covering various
  aspects from academics to co-curricular to events to placements and finally their work
  experience in industry. The points that expressed by them included
  - Real time projects to be given to students.
  - Students need to be given training with a horizontal plane emphasis so that they
    get aware of the multiple disciplines that they may encounter in work place.
  - Programming Tools and Software to be introduced in curriculum in tune with the current industry requirements.

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- Appreciation of the Campus Recruitment Training (CRT) program for placements being conducted by the college under the flag of MJCET Alumni Association and its fruitful results.
- Communication skills especially the soft skills need to improved and actions to be taken in this regard.
- Then the ITD faculty members were asked to express their views and concerns.

- As OBE is student oriented, concern regarding student attendance was raised.
- Concerns about the completion of syllabus in the light of the additional tasks to be done were echoed.
- All the members expressed their readiness to this new approach as it was in the better interest of the student.
- Members representing the Professional Bodies Representatives then presented their views:
  - Dr. Salman Abdul Moiz, Associated Professor, SCIS, UoH, stressed on the need to revive the Campus Connect program to improve the employability opportunities of the graduates.
  - Dr. Atul Negi, Professor, SCIS, UoH and Chair Executive Committee IEEE Hyderabad Section made his observations
    - Appreciated the way the meeting was being conducted, especially the compilation of the documents pertaining to department and the DAB meeting, the mails sent to the members before the meet, the DAB documents given in person.
    - He enquired from the youngest faculty in the department about her experience and also made a discussion with the department faculty on different aspects related to academics, facilitates etc.
    - He observed the fact the facilities in the department met the curriculum requirements i.e. it is a curriculum infrastructure. Further that there is no separate Server Machine under and managed by the IT department catering to its computing needs.
    - He also stressed that students should be given exposure to configuration of the Servers, Networking, and Maintenance of systems, dealing with virus attacks and should be entrusted the maintenance of a network so that they get a practical exposure to the nitty-gritty of IT Infrastructure Maintenance, which is needed for an IT Graduate
    - He called for setting up of specialized labs i.e. sensor based for example.
    - He expressed that the lack of professional exposure (which was a global phenomena and existed everywhere). It requires filling the gap between academia and industry by means of ties ups with industry and government RandD consultancies to hone the student skills.

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- New students, especially the First year and II year students should not face the new faculties (less experienced)
- He highlighted the need for having various professional body chapters to improve student's professional exposure and make then industry ready. In this regard he named a few bodies such as SWEBOK, Computer Software Development Professionals body of IEEE, etc.
- In order to make students do projects in multidisciplinary domains, he suggested that large number of Sensor Devices to be used in Embedded systems lab
- Out of box thinking needs to be developed in students.
- IT should be made as interdisciplinary as possible by integrating different domain problems and having a solution for them in terms of a computer program, for example to solve the chemistry related problems using a computer program, similarly integration of mathematics oriented subjects with IT is needed.

 Mr. P.V.Rao, Consultant, Information Technology and Electronics and Communication Department, Govt. of AP, who represented the employer then presented his suggestions.

- Formal interactions among students and alumni is needed to make students aware about the current requirements of industry and facilitate them to keep themselves abreast of latest technologies which brightens the chances of employability of students
- Emphasis should be given to Entrepreneurship skills of the students and in this regards, college must have certain incubation center for the same
- Integration of IT and ECE projects is need of the day.
- · Dr. Sudarsan Jena, Professor, GITAM University expressed the fact that
  - For involvement of students in RandD projects, the faculty needs to guide the students in current research oriented topics.
  - Syllabus needs to be redesigned keeping in mind the current IT needs.( i.e. within the purview of the OU syllabus, additional value add on should be provided).
  - Internships be concentrated upon for having an early exposure to the corporate world for a smooth absorption in it later.
- Dr. Kaleem Fatima, Head ECE Dept and member Core Committee NBA, stressed on the need for the faculty to improve their profile.
  - It was suggested to divide the curriculum into three categories, viz, Must Know, Need to Know, Nice to know.
  - Assessment methods to be relaxed so that an oral or a written mode whichever is beneficial and facilitating to the students is to be adopted.

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- Mrs. Fouzia Sayeedunnisa, Associate Professor and Program Coordinator, informed the board members that more and more number of research oriented projects are being given to the students to harness the analytical and problem solving abilities of students.
- Dr. Atul Negi enquired about the assessment methods to be adopted to measure the
  outcomes of IT program. He was briefed about the same by Head ITD and Dr. Kaleem
  Fatima, Head ECE, and the assessment methods listed were
  - Written tests (Internal and External)
  - Oral tests (Quizzes, Viva Voce)
  - Projects, seminars
  - · GATE qualification
  - · University Ranks etc
- Dr. M. M. Hussain, Professor of Geology, Deccan College of Engineering and Technology, who represented the parents, expressed that the students be given motivational lectures to make students oriented towards career improvement.
- Department faculties also expressed their views on the outcome based education and illustrated as to how they are going to implement the same.
- It was in general observed 'that the department should improve on the fronts of placements, MoUs with industry and RandD sector, Integration of IT with other disciplines.
- Then the Draft copy of PEOs formulated by the department in consultation with all faculty members was presented before the board for its scrutiny.
- The board members expressed their concerns on outcomes and methods of assessments on the presented PEOs which were clarified by the Head.
- The draft copy of the PEOs were approved by the board and it was informed by the Head
  that the outcomes of the program after next semester will be mailed to the board
  members, and a detailed analysis of same would to be done in the next DAB meeting
- Mementos were presented to the members of DAB.
