(i) Prevention of Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking





(i) ART BEATS

IEEE CIS- MJCET SB organized an event "ART BEATS" on 9th March 2018. The purpose of this event was to enlighten students regarding women centric issues and provide them with a platform to showcase their creativity in the form of art and craft. The theme of the event revolved around women empowerment related issues. The competitions, namely "Pot painting, poster painting, clay modeling, lantern making, best out of waste" were conducted, and the second day of event, International Women's day were celebrated and an eminent speaker Mrs. Percis Bobdoom, nutritionist was invited as chief guest and addressed the students regarding the challenges faced by women. She enlightened on various women health issues and emphasized the importance of a proper diet and supplements for women. Students had shown various documentaries highlighting the role of women and their importance in our everyday life. She focused on the importance of healthy competition, confidence and encouraged students to take up various challenges. She motivated students with her various

personal instances of life to pursue the passion and how women should never undervalue their abilities.



(ii) "How Safe are you? With regard to safety for Women & children"

A talk on "Be Smarter and Cyber Safe" was conducted by Rakshit Tandon on February 17, 2018

Dr. Rakshit Tandon, who is also the Advisor – Minority Affairs for the Committee of Child Protection in Digital Age, was addressing a gathering of school and college students and young engineers during a seminar on "How Safe Are You?" at Ghulam Ahmed Hall in Sultan ul Uloom Education Society. Citing statistics of the National Crime Record Bureau of India, he said "5102 were arrested in 2015 of which nearly 3200 were college students, and 98 were school students."

He warned students against being lured into cyber terrorism by strangers referring to Internet "as an open space" which is being used for terrorism. He was referring to 3,77,000 suspicious accounts that were closed by Twitter in 2016. He advised girls to be cautious while using platforms like Snapchat and WhatsApp as certain features like Screen capture can help their private data escape publicly. Even deleted pictures and data posted online have a traceable footprint, he warned.

He warned the students of Section 67 which allows for punishment for publishing or transmitting obscene material in electronic form, Section 66C which recognizes hacking as a punishable crime, and Section 67A which calls for a non-bailable jail for 5 years and up to 10 lakh rupees in fine for sexually explicit content.

(i) Naari Shakti

Each year, March 8th – and the week in which it falls – provides an opportunity to take stock of our progress towards gender equality and to honour the contributions women have made and are making around the world. This International Women's Day, we came together in solidarity to celebrate our progress and to resist the patriarchal, communal and regressive forces that are operating with utter impunity in our country.

On the occasion of International Women's day, an awareness program "Naari Shakthi" is organised by IEEE MJCET SB on 8th March 2017 in Gulam Ahmed Auditorium, MJCET. In the present era menstruation is often not discussed openly and the silence of it in young girls is keeping them ignorant of the biological process going on in their body. Proper guidance and knowledge lack among many young girls on their physiological process, communal misbeliefs and hygienic practices to be followed. An awareness talk was conducted by Dr. Arshia Azam, Principal ITI, MANUU.

Suffering is the root cause of Revolution, with this intention of making young girls aware of the Menstrual hygiene, Prevention from Anaemia and Prevention from Sexual Harassment. MJCET has conducted an awareness talk in collaboration with SHE Team Hyderabad that gave insights for many young girls in the college regarding the menstrual hygienic methods and tips and also filled them with the courage and strength to fight against sexual harassment by the new methods of SHE Team.

A talk by a representative of SHE team member gave insights of atrocities against women in Hyderabad and the actions taken by them. Waiting for a protection force is secondary but the courage to fight against the abuse is required on moment i.e., self-defense how to protect themselves through various means. The talk also included the means of reporting harassments by reaching out to them through helplines and social media, and the actions to protect the victim. Few laws that protects the girls and the rights were also discussed and the assurance of keeping the information of victim confidential is also been added. Doubts of the young girls in reaching SHE team and their actions against atrocities are clarified at the end of the session by interacting with the speaker.

(ii) Professional Leadership & Cyber Security Challenges for Professional Women

IEEE MJCET SB Women in Engineering Affinity Group (WIE-AG) conducted half-day workshop on "Professional Leadership & Cyber Security Challenges" at Student Activity center, Block-2, Hyderabad. The Theme of the event is "Aware & Explore to Build a Strong New Woman of yourself". To create yourself "A New Woman with Confidence" to encourage yourself and to excel beyond any obstacles facing in your life, on 17th January 2017, in order to get awareness of crimes- causes and finding a solution to develop a technical career for safe India through professional leadership to "Explore your World & Explore your Life," from 9 AM to 1 PM.

(Student Teacher And Research)" Program at Muffakham Jah College of engineering during the college fest "Adsophos" on 16th February 2015. Sultan ul uloom school students (about 150 students) of 8th grade participated in this program.

The students were first introduced to the exciting models and events made by the Robotics club of Mjcet where there were shown Robo soccer, Robo sumo, Mars Rover.
